- Clean substance abuse test

- Class work involving electrical/electronics theory. You can earn up to fifty hours of transferable college credit. Both associate and bachelor degree options are available in Electrical Construction Technology.

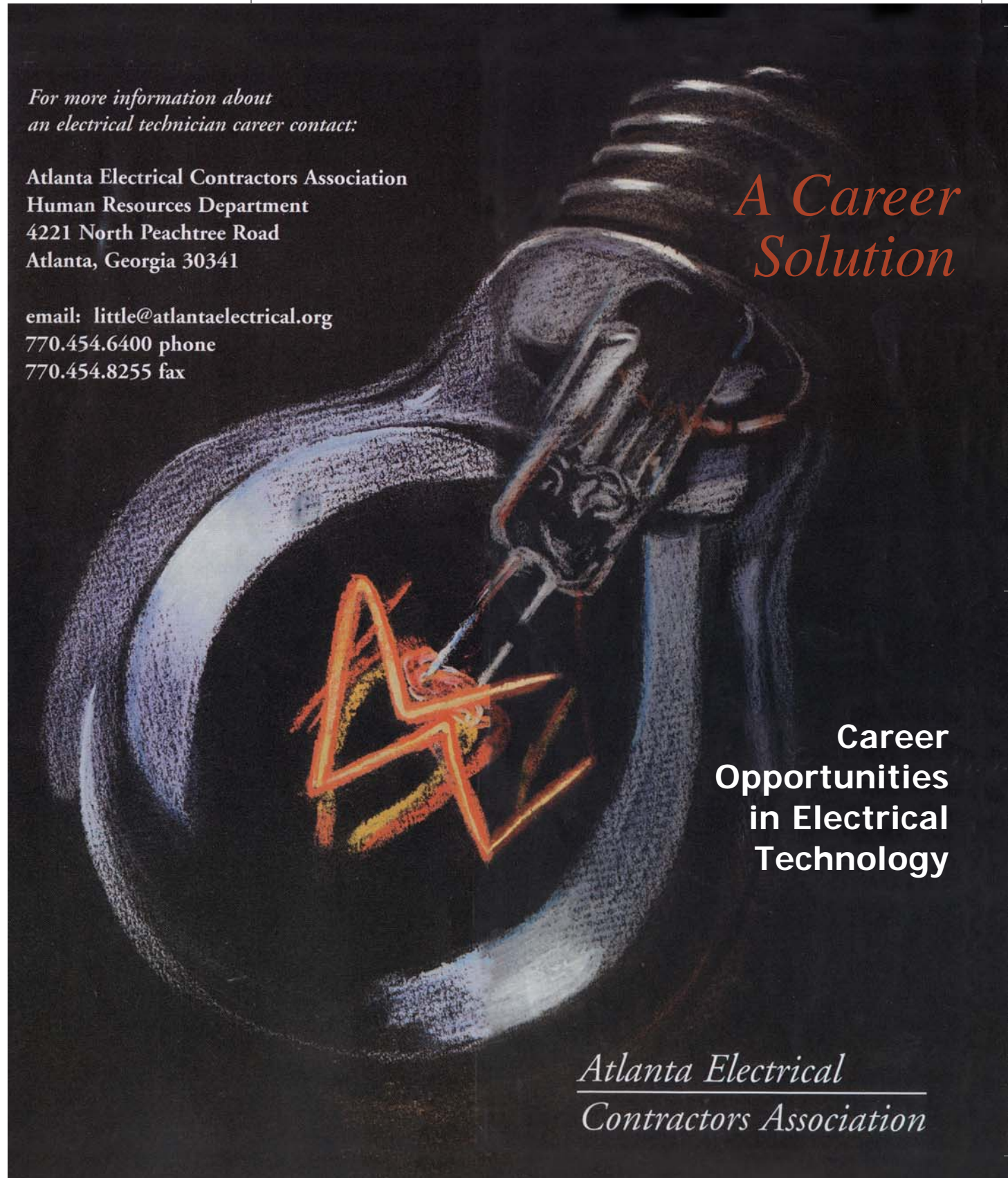
